## Portraits painted on walls of DU campus removed

All the portraits painted on the walls of Dhaka University campus by different student organisations with "political motive" were removed on Sunday, reports UNB.

The portraits were removed at about 11 a.m. in presence of the university authorities and student leaders as per the decision of the Paribesh Parishad meeting held on Saturday.

DU Vice-Chancellor Prof. AK Azad Chowdhury, proctor Dr. AKM Noor-un-Nabi, provosts and house tutors and leaders of different student organisations were present.

The decision to remove the portraits was taken as part of the agreement signed between the university authorities and student bodies on July 31.

The eight-point deal was aimed at breaking the deadlock created on the campus after BNP-backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal enforced an indefinite strike at the university.

JCD called the nonstop strike after the pro-Awami League Chhatra League captured the Surya Sen Hall on July 24 and painted the portrait of
