Call to maintain DU academic atmosphere

A meeting of Environment Council (Paribesh Parishad) of Dhaka University on Saturday asked all concerned not to give any programme which might disrupt the academic atmosphere of the university before the submission of the report by the Probe-body formed to investigate into the sex-scandal.

The meeting said if anybody launches any agitation programme on the campus violating the decision of the Environment Council would be accountable to the Environment Council.

Chaired by Vice-Chancellor of the university Prof AK Azad Chowdhury, the meeting was attended by the leaders of different student organisations including Pro-Awami League, Chhatra League (BCL), Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), Bangladesh Chhatra Moitré, Bangladesh Chhatra League (C-K) and Bangladesh Chhatra Front.

The meeting also urged the body to complete inquiry immediately even against any teacher, if any.
