## DU pays tribute to martyred intellectuals

The teachers and officials of Dhaka University on Monday held a discussion meeting at the Teachers Student Centre (TSC) to mark the Martyred Intellectuals Day.

The meeting, with Vice-Chancellor Prof. A K Azad Chowdhury in the chair, was attended, among others, by Prof. Shaduddin, Prof. Yusuf Haider—President of the Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA), Prof Hossain Mansur—General Secretary of DUTA, Mohammed Selim—Registrar and Nurul Islam—President of the 'Class Four Employees' Association.

Demanding trial of the killers of the intellectuals, Prof. Azad Chowdhury said, "We lost the spirit that we had during the Liberation War. It is now time to regain that."

The meeting was conducted by Mohammed Selim.

Earlier in the morning a procession of teachers, students and officials led by the Vice-Chancellor laid wreaths on the graves of the martyred intellectuals at the university's central mosque premises.

Floral wreaths were also placed at Mirpur Martyred Intellectuals Mausoleum by the teachers, students of different halls and student organisations.
