

JCD to resist Hasina's DU visit

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), the student wing of main opposition BNP, on Friday announced that they will resist the planned visit to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to the Dhaka University on Monday (January 5), reports UNB.

According to Press reports, the Prime Minister will lay the foundation of a multi-storied building on the DU campus on Monday.

Addressing a Press conference at the Madhu's Canteen in the afternoon, JCD President Shaheeduddin Chowdhury Anny said they will stage demonstration with black flags if Sheikh Hasina visits the campus.
