Campaign on for registered graduates election to DU Senate

Hectic campaign is going on for the upcoming election of the 25 registered graduate representatives to the Dhaka University Senate.

Pro-Awami League Ganatantrik Oikya Parishad, as a part of their nation-wide campaign, held a projection meeting to introduce its candidates on Saturday in Pirojpur.

The meeting was held at the Iskander Welfare Foundation Auditorium and was chaired by Principal of the Government Sohrawardy College Prof. Zainal Abedin.

Indicating the anti-terrorism drive as their target, the speakers said that fighting terrorism is only possible by a democratic force and urged the voters to cast their votes for the democratic panel only which is the Ganatantrik Oikya Parishad.

The meeting was addressed, among others, by former President of Pirojpur District Lawyers' Association Advocate Akram Hossain, Shah-e-Alam and Advocate S.M. Fuad.
