Documentary film on history of DU to be made

A documentary film on the history of Dhaka University is going to be made. Initiated by a University official, the project was inaugurated at a simple ceremony at the office of the Vice-Chancellor on Wednesday.

The documentary film will include all the significant events that took place in the University and those, which put an impact on the history of the nation since establishment of the University in 1921.

Earlier, while talking to the Bangladesh Observer, the maker of the documentary, Deputy Director of the student counselling section Syed Rezaul Rahman said, that the work would not have any political touch in it. "But if history demands, I'll have to add some political events or even personalities to the work," he added.

"We don't have any complete work on the history of the University preserved in any form", said Mr. Rahman.

The project was officially inaugurated through the speech of the Vice Chancellor Prof. A.K. Azad Chowdhury. The speech of the Pro-Vice Chancellor Prof. Md. Shahadat Ali was also recorded on the same day on Wednesday. Both the VC and Pro VC, in their speeches stressed on the glorious history of the University. They also mentioned the importance of projects like this.

Member of the Video Script Committee of the project Prof. Golam Rahman of the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism and Assistant Professor Syeda Firoza Begum of the Institute of Social Welfare and Research were also present at the VC's office during the programme.
