DU girl students demand removal of warden

Women students of a hostel of the Dhaka University demanded immediate removal of the dormitory's warden, reports UNB.

The students of Nawab Faizunnesa Chowdhurani Chhatriti Nibash alleged that the warden of the hostel Razia Begum tortured them in many ways for the last four years.

They alleged that the warden ousted two residential students, Sonia Zahan and Rabeya Aktar of Geography Department, on the night of Pahela Baishakh as they were late.

The students organised a press conference on Friday evening at TSC and M Phil student Mina Roy read out the written statement.

The warden Razia Begum ousted a former resident Bilkis on April 20 at 9:30 p.m from the hostel. Other residents protested her order terming it as inhuman and brought out a procession on the night.

The students said that the tenure of the warden was completed on April 20 and she was now on extension.

They alleged that whenever any student tried to protest her dictatorship, the warden created trouble in various ways.
