

Result today DU Senate polls end

The Dhaka University Senate election for the 25 registered graduates representatives ended on Wednesday and the result will be announced today (Thursday) after counting of the votes.

On the last day of the election on Wednesday the polls were held in the two centres in Dhaka. Polls were held peacefully in the two centres where nearly 6000 voters cast their votes, sources said. The centres were the University Gymnasium and the Teachers Students Centre (TSC).

A total of 31424 registered graduates were listed to exercise their rights to vote to elect 25 of their representatives in the highest decision-making body of the university. 211 candidates vied in the election under the banner of four different panels. The panels are: Ganotantrik Oikya Parishad, backed by pro-liberation forces, BNP and their like minded parties supported panel Jatiyatabadi Oikya Parishad, left leaning parties supported Pragati parishad and the Independent Unity Council—without any support from any party.

Counting of votes will begin at 9 a.m. today (Thursday) at T.S.C. and Gymnasium Centres of the university.
