General students at DU announce fresh programmes

Students of Dhaka University demonstrating under the banner of 'students protesting sexual harassment' have announced fresh programmes in support of their demands.

The programmes include sit-in demonstration in front of the office of the Vice-Chancellor after a procession on the campus on January 6.

Earlier on Tuesday the movement of these students got a new dimension when a number of university teachers, intellectuals, political organisations, and some socio-cultural bodies expressed solidarity with the demonstrating students.

They organised a Press briefing at Madhu's canteen on Thursday to inform the Press of their next programmes.

The students, mostly female, will bring out a procession on January 5. It may be mentioned that the processions of these students were attacked by another group of students under the banner of 'conscious students'.

Leaders of the 'students protesting sexual harassment', at the press briefing vowed to continue their movement.

They will organise a programme of 'open discussion' on January 3 at the Teachers Students Centre (TSC) seminar room on 'the movement against sexual harassment' at Dhaka University and their six-point demand.

Teachers, students, intellectuals and political leaders will take part in the discussion meeting.
