JCD's call to take action against outsiders at DU Halls

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), student wing of BNP on Saturday warned the Dhaka University authorities that they would go for a tough movement if the authorities did not take any action against the outsider terrorists staying at different residential halls of the university.

Bringing allegations against the Vice-Chancellor, JCD leaders said, "the VC is giving shelter to the outsiders, otherwise the police action at Zahurul Haq Hall on Thursday could have been a success".

The JCD leaders were addressing a rally held in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office. They were protesting against the 'terrorist act' at Zahurul Haq Hall.

Meanwhile, a three-member committee formed on Friday to probe into Thursday's incident is likely to start its work today (Sunday). The committee, headed by the Provost of Zahurul Haq Hall Prof MA Mannan, has been given ten days time to submit its report.
