

Ex-BCL activists again lock IU entrance

A GROUP of former Bangladesh Chhatra League activists of Islamic University in Kushtia unit, also former students of the university, on Tuesday again locked main entrance of the campus demanding jobs at the university.

Witness said a group of ex-BCL activists, including Mahbubor Rahman Khokon, Rashel Jowarder, Elias Jowader, Anisuzzaman Lion, locked university main entrance around 9:00am and it was continued till 4:00pm.

Some university buses came to the campus early morning but the buses did not able to go out of the campus due to the blockade.

However, classes and examinations were not held. Teachers, employees and students of the campus faced transport strike for a long time.

A viva board of Economics department postponed their examinations for an unavoidable reason.

Rashel Jowarder said that they would continue their agitation until the university authorities would take any effective step to meet their demands.

When contacted, vice-chancellor Abdul Hakim Sarker said that the problems would be settled soon.

'I have informed the higher authorities of the matter,' he said.
