CU BCL may enforce siege Programme.

CHITTAGONG, Oct 22:— Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) of Chittagong University (CU) unit likely to enforce an indefinite siege programme on the campus from next week.

BCL will call this agitation programme in protest against the ongoing oppression by Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) on BCL activists in CU as well as general students of the university.

While talking with Nasir Haidar Babul, General Secretary of CU BCL, said to the Bangladesh Observer, will discuss the present situation of the university with the authority of CU on October 26 or 27. We will place our demands to them for the security of the students as well as our activists in CU.

If the authority of CU could not give proper security to our leaders and activists then we will go for agitation programme including siege programme along with the general students of the university, Babul said.

At this decision the academic future of the university now goes to the uncertainty again. The classes of CU remain closed from October 20 to November 1 due to the Autumn and Durga Puja vacation. Earlier, classes of CU resumed from October 10 after a lapse of two months as the authority of CU closed the university sine die following a clash between ICS and BCL which left more than 20 students on August 13.
