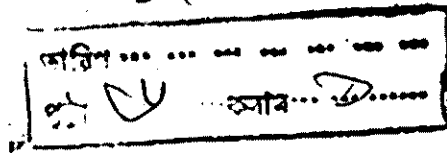

First ever CU day celebration

CHITTAGONG, July 2:—There is a time in the recent past when the students of other universities called Chittagong University 'university of cultural barren'. Now CU has overcome that time and not lacking behind the other universities. CU celebrated its first ever 'CU Day' on July 27 (Thursday) with a festive mood.

With the 'CU Day theme' "Eso li praner utshabe" (let us join in the ceremony of life) CU wore a unprecedented festive look. Several thousand students of the university were overwhelmed with joy in celebration of the first ever university day after establishment in 1966.

The day started with the colourful shuttle train rally from the Battali Railway Station of the city. A pair of university shuttle trains, which were decorated tastefully, sailed from the city. Thousand of present and former students of the university joined the train rally. All the shuttle train group of the university that included Always,

Angels, Cherubim, Cockpit, War Gods, Bairagi, Uranchandi and others painted their respective shuttle train compartments with the colours as it seems that rainbow came down at the station from the sky. Wearing the respective group's T-shirt, headband and scarf they gathered in the Battali railway station from the very early of the morning with dhol, tabla, guitar, flute and other musical instruments. Railway station looked a tremendous mood of fair. The festive mood got another dimension as the shuttle trains started for university railway station. The compartments of the shuttle trains jam-packed with the hundred thousand students of CU. All the students sang and danced all the way. The people beside the railway tracks clapped and cheered up the students while the trains passing, them.

While the two shuttle trains reached the university railway station thousand of resident students of CU dormitories along with the CU Vice-Chancellor, Dr Fazlee Hossain teachers and employees of the university welcomed them and the whole railway station looked like a 'festival bomb'.

The VC of CU formally inaugurated the grand rally of the first ever 'CU Day' at 10.30 a.m. and the wave of the colourful rally of the 'sea of the thousand' started

marching towards the main stage of CU Day at 'Janul Tala'. The green coloured CU campus covered by the rainbow colour when the main procession marched towards the CU Day stage with dance, song, holding placards, festoons and banner. "It is a great day for us as we are the most lucky students of CU who celebrate the CU Day for the first time.
