CU campus Shibir to break ban on campus politics

CHITTAGONG, Aug. 4:—Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) will formally break the ban decision of CU authority on political activities on the campus by bringing out a procession tomorrow (Sunday). While talking with the Bangladesh Observer Alauddin Shikdar, the President of CU ICS disclosed this.

CU ICS President said that the ban decision on political activities on the campus is for only ICS not for Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) activists. BCL men clapped in the University Rail Station and tea stalls of the university campus, walked unitedly like procession and the authority of CU could not do anything against them, he added.

"We want to show that BCL is not only the student organisation in CU campus and for that reason we will bring out a procession" said ICS of CU Unit President. Besides, ICS, the student wing of Jamaat-e-Islami, has already announced their indefinite strike on CU campus from August 10 to realise their demands.

On the other hand, BCL student wing of Awami League again clarified their position about the Rehabilitation of ICS activists in Shahjalal Hall and Shah Amanat Hall. The President of CU BCL said, we always welcomed allotted legal students in these two halls. But in the name of rehabilitation ICS cadres will stay in the two halls which is absurd.

About the Environmental Council (EC) of CU he said, we demanded immediate cancellation of the EC as there are some controversial persons included there in Without mentioning any name CU BCL President said some teachers who have involved in the blue print of killing BCL men are included in this EC. So we oppose this EC and demanded to form another EC with neutral persons.

Meanwhile, the EC invited all the political organisations of CU to meet with them for the purpose of normalising the present critical situation that prevails on the campus.

However the EC today sat with all Provosts of CU halls to discuss on the same issue at 3 p.m. in the Administrative Building of CU. Vice-Chancellor of CU Fazlee Hossain presided over the meeting. But the outcome of the meeting could not be know till this report was being filed.

On the other hand, many students of the university are yet to come as they feared a bloody clash between ICS and BCL over the hall capturing issue.
