

SUB observes Teachers' Day

State University of Bangladesh (SUB) held a seminar on World Teachers' Day recently at the seminar room of the university. The theme of this year's WTD was "Teachers Create Dialogue Every Day". The United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization—UNESCO, observe the day since 1994. This year the day has been observed in one hundred and fifteen countries including Bangladesh, says a Press release.
