



Absence of canteens

Non-resident students of DU facing problem

Non-resident students of Dhaka University have been facing acute problem in taking lunch due to absence of adequate canteens on the campus for long but the authorities have little attention in this regard, reports UNB.

The DU students of most of the faculties have to attend classes for whole day that compelled them to take lunch on the campus.

Though the DU authorities provide launch items at the TSC, DUCSU and Science cafeterias, most of the students have to face the problem due to limited number of meals in these canteens.

Only 400 to 500 students can have their meals at these canteens, sources said. Moreover, access of outsiders into these canteens deprives many students from taking food.

The resident students of various dormitories can have their lunches in their hall messes where the students themselves run those under the supervision of the house tutors.

Apart from the mentioned canteens, there are a few canteens on the campus, including IBA canteen, a canteen inside the Charukala Institute and few mobile ones.
