



DU classes resume today

Classes of Dhaka University resume today (Wednesday) after a long "unscheduled vacation" caused by the non-stop student strike enforced by Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).

The university's academic activities were disrupted since July 29 after JCD, the student wing of BNP enforced the shutdown. On Saturday JCD called off the strike after its parent-organisation's landslide victory in the October 1 elections.

The university Syndicate on the eve of reopening the university urged all student organisations to restore congenial academic atmosphere on the campus for peaceful coexistence of all party activists.

The Syndicate at an emergency meeting on Tuesday also expressed its concern over illegal staying of outsiders in the dormitories of the university and the incident of assaulting a journalist on Monday.

The Syndicate urged the law enforcing agencies to intensify security measures on the campus to avoid further untoward incidents.
