## DU Authority hold talks with JCD leaders

The Dhaka University authorities on Tuesday held a meeting with the ruling party's student wing Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) to improve the campus situation.

It was a part of the university authorities' ongoing dialogues with the student organisations to improve the situation following the gun fight of November 13 at Jagannath Hall and Sergeant Zahurul Huq Hall.

JCD's DU unit president Monir Hossain led the JCD delegation during the talks with Vice Chancellor Prof Anwarullah Chowdhury and Proctor Prof Nazrul Islam.

The JCD leaders gave their total support to the authorities' move to maintain a congenial atmosphere on the campus.

After the talks Monir Hossain said "We know the actual misery of living outside the halls as the Chhatra League ousted us for last five years. So, We don't want to keep any genuine student outside the dorms".

"But, we will not tolerate any terrorist in the dorms in the name of politics," he added.

Meanwhile, leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) submitted a list of their ousted activists to the proctor.

The Proctor said the authorities would rehabilitate them after necessary verification.
