



Islamic varsity Prof arrested

KUSHTIA, Aug. 18:—Police physically assaulted and arrested a teacher of Islamic University allegedly for trying to forcibly enter into a women's hall in a drunken state at dead of Friday night, reports UNB.

Prof Moyeedur Rahman of Economics Department injured in police assault was admitted to Kushtia general hospital this morning.

His family and students accused the police of inhuman torturing on Prof Moyeed before arrest.

OC Sirajul Islam of Campus thana said Prof Moyeed tried to forcibly enter into the women's hall in a drunken state at 12 midnight. When duty police resisted, he attacked them with bottle of alcohol resulting in injury to two cops.

"It is beyond imagination that a university teacher in a drunken state will try to enter the women's dormitory in the campus and attack law enforcers for trying to refrain him," said OC Siraj.

Police filed a case against Prof Moyeed under the Public Safety Act.

Doctors in the hospital refrained from commenting when asked if Prof Moyeed was found drunk when brought to the hospital this morning. They said it would be ascertained after examination.

Students in the university campus condemned the police torture on Prof Moyeed, as tension was boiling, the authority at 12 noon deployed para military BDR and riot police in the campus to ward off untoward incident.
