



Sylhet edn. office in pitiable condition

Punitive action against 998 SSC, HSC examinees for cheating

MOULVIBAZAR, Dec. 26:—The Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, Sylhet, has taken punitive action against 998 examinees for adopting unfair means in the SSC and the HSC examinations held in 2001. The decision has been taken recently in the second and the third meetings of the Disciplinary Committee of the Board.

According to the Board source, out of penalised examinees, 456 students are SSC examinees while 542 others are HSC examinees. Of the penalised SSC examinees 308 examinees are barred from taking part in the examination for one year, while 147 examinees for two years and one examinee for three years.

On the other hand out of the total HSC penalised examinees accused of adopting unfair means, 395 examinees are barred

from taking part in the examination for one year, while 145 examinees for two years and 2 examinees for 4 years.

The tin-shed office-house of the Moulvibazar District Education Office is now in a dilapidated condition. The staff of the office at the risking of life.

Owing to shortage of staff, furniture, worn-out condition of walls, doors and windows and many other problems prevailing daily business of the office has being hindered.

The tin-shed and pucca-wall was established on .22 decimals of land in the court area of Moulvibazar town more than a hundred years ago. At present, the office-building has been started as the base of the house has subsided and breaches at many points of different walls of the building have developed.

The tins of the office have been rusted and holes in different

points have developed result of and rain-water fall inside house of the furniture, important papers and books and files within the office in many cases got wet by the rain-water.

The doors and the window of the office and most of the furniture have become worn-out.

Staff shortage

The post of District Education Officer has been lying vacant causing problems to run daily business of the office.

The shortage of several staff like ADEO, clerk, M/sweeper etc. are also hindering the normal business here.

The education office has no road to go to the office. The staff and visitors of the office pass the office through a plot of land belonging to other department.

The authorities concerned should take immediate steps to solve the problems of the office.
