



Collection of extra money from SSC candidates in Khulna protested

KHULNA, Dec. 1:— Authorities of different schools in Khulna are collecting 2/3 times more money against fixed rate for filling in forms by Board Authority from SSC candidates. Students and guardians of SSC candidates made this complaints.

Different student organizations have already held rallies, took out processions and submitted memorandum to the concerned authorities protesting this unethical work.

Poor and lower middle class guardians are the worst victims of this situation. Many of whom were also forced to borrow money for their kids.

A source from District Education Office said, fixed rates for filling forms for SSC examinees are 590 Taka for Science Group and 550 Taka for Commerce and Humanities Groups.

But schools are collecting extra 1200-1800 Taka as compulsory payment showing causes of coachin and tiffin.

Guardians and students informed that the authorities of Khulna Zila School, Coronation School, Model School, BK School and many other schools have already collected extra fees from the students.

Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Chhatra Federation Chhatra Moitri protested this unethical activities by school authorities and took out processions, hold rallies and gave memoranda to
