18 posts out of 42 lying vacant

Acute teacher shortage in Adina Fazlul Huq College

CHAPAI-NAWABGANJ, Mar 13.—The Adina Fazlul Haque Government College the oldest educational institution in Chapai-Nawabganj district is in grip of multifarious problems hindering imparting of education to the students.

The renowned educationist late Krishnendu Mian a close associate of the then Chief Minister of Undivided Bengal, Sher-e-Bangla AKM Fazlul Haque set up the college in 1938 and was nationalised in 1986.

The imparting of proper education to the students in the college is being hindered due to the acute shortage of teachers. The number of sanctioned posts of teachers in the college for 14 subjects is 42. But 18 posts of teachers have remained vacant for a long period.

The subject-wise vacancies are: Bangla one, English one, Economics one, Islamic History one, History one, Chemistry one, Botany one, Mathematics one, Accounting one, Zoology two, Physics two and Political

Science two.

The posts of demonstrator, librarian, physical instructor, head office assistant and night guard have been lying vacant for a long time.

The post of the Principal of the college has also remained vacant. The shortage of teachers is hindering the academic pursuit in the college. The students are not getting adequate classes to finish their courses.

On Feb 19 last, the students of the college staged demonstration and kept the college under lock and key for a day demanding immediate steps to fillup the vacant posts of teachers and employees to ensure holding of classes regularly.

No auditorium

The college authority has repeatedly apprised the concerned authorities of the acute shortage of teachers but no substantial steps have so far been taken for it.

The college does not have auditorium, library room, quarters for the principal and the vice-

principal, common room and hostel for the girl students and boundary wall to protect its sanctity.

Introduce honours course

The conscious circle of Shibganj upazila (where the college is situated) have laid stress on the opening of honours courses in the college which will benefit the students having no financial capability to do honours staying in hostels or messes.

The concerned authorities should take proper steps to solve the problems in order to ensure proper education to hundreds of students of the college.

Relief for distressed

The government has provided 438 metric tonnes of rice to 43800 distressed families in 438 wards of 45 unions and 3 pourashabhas of the district on the occasion of Eid-ul-Azha.

In every ward 100 distressed families have received 10 kgs of rice each.
