Libirites file cases against 249 JL, BCL members

RAJSHAHI, Feb 27:—A total of four cases under Public Safety Act (PSA) and one case under Penal Code have been filed with Rajshahi Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (CMM) Court against 249 leaders and workers of the ruling party's front organisations Juba League (JL) and Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) today.

Court sources said the cases were filed in connection with the RU incident on February 16.

RU student Hafizur Rahman lodged a case against 65 JL and BCL leaders and workers for damaging and ransacking the rooms of RU Fine Arts Building. Another RU student Ahsan Ullah filed a case against 80 people for looting and damaging the student messes at Meherchandi. Two businessmen of RU Station Market Khorshed Alam and Shamim Reza filed two separate cases against 104 students each. Besides one Rashidul filed a case against 22 leaders and workers of JL and BCL.

The plaintiffs of the aforesaid cases were reported to be the leaders and activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir.
