



BCL, JCD clash, 20 rooms ransacked at DMC

A clash between Bangladesh Chattra League (BCL) and Jata-yatabadi Chatra Dal (JCD) took place early on Thursday escalating tension on the campus, reports UNB.

After the clash, the DMC authorities in an emergency meeting formed an 11-member committee to investigate into the matter and asked the student organisations to refrain from violent acts in the college or its dormitories.

Witnesses said the trouble ensued when a group of BCL leaders attacked some JCD activists at Fazle Rabbi Hall at about 3 a.m. ransacking 15-20 rooms of the dormitory. An unspecified number of bombs were exploded on the campus, including in front of the hall provost, during the clash.

Later, both groups locked all gates of the college barring its officials and teachers to enter the college.

Police have been deployed on the campus as tension continued to simmer following the clash.
