

SAVAR, Nov 13:- Removed Vice Chancellor of Jahangirnagar University Prof Abdul Bayes today said he would seek legal remedy against his removal, reports UNB.

"I'm an elected VC and the clause under which I was sacked is an obsolete law of British period," he said while talking to journalists at the university TSC.

The former Vice Chancellor termed his removal by that clause a "dishonour" to the University Ordinance 1973.

In another development, Proctor Prof Ajit Kumar Majumder today tendered his resignation showing "personal reason" and the new VC Prof Jashim Uddin accepted his resignation.

Associate Professor Enam Ulah Parvez of Chemistry Department has been made the new Proctor.

Prof Bayes claimed that he had maintained peaceful atmosphere on the campus and implemented development works involving Tk 44 crore during his term from 1999.

Moreover, the session jam was reduced to 8 months from 16 months, he added.

Prof Bayes demanded Senate election within 40 days and claimed that he would again be elected.

Meanwhile, JU Teachers Association in an emergency meeting today condemned the "undemocratic removal" of the VC and urged the teachers to abstain from classes tomorrow (Wednesday).
