

19th day of strike

Teachers invite Edn Minister for talk

In a bid to resolve the long stalemate in non-government academic institutions across the country, the Jatiya Shikha Kar-machari Oikya Jote (Shariful) has invited the Education minister for discussion on Wednesday, reports BD News.

"Since no discussion was held despite the directives from the Prime Minister, we are inviting the Education Minister for discussion", the Jote (Shariful) president said on the 19th day of indefinite strike.

The meeting, according to the leaders, will be held at 3:30 pm on July 30 at the Mohammadiapur Central College.

Besides, the other faction of Jote (Selim Bhuiyan) staged a sit-in in front of the DC offices across the country, while their siege pro-

gramme at Shikha Bhaban could not be held in the face of police barricade.

"Finance Minister Saifur Rahman and State Minister for Education, Ehsanul Haque Milon, in collusion with the opposition are trying to foil the movement. The wantew to become ministers of AL if it comes to power", the alleged.

The National Front of Teacher and Employees (NFTE), said, "fruitful meeting between the PM and the Finance Minister would do, if the Government sincerely wants to resolve the crisis".

Meanwhile, Abdus Salam Pintu, deputy minister for Information, said the discussion would be held soon as he is maintaining telephonic discussion with the leaders.
