

Ctg varsity expels 8 BCL cadres

CHITTAGONG, Mar 19:- Eight cadres of BCL, the student wing of ruling Awami League, were today expelled for one year from the Chittagong University for their unruly activities, reports UN. The students expelled are Rashedul Hannan, Fazle Rabbi, Saifwarul Islam, Rakib Hasan, Zahedul Islam, Asperul Haq, Ahsan Siddiqi and Iftekharul Haider.

The university authority has asked them and 12 other BCL cadres to show cause within seven days to explain why further stringent action would not be taken against them, said the university sources.

The action was taken upon report of an inquiry committee comprising proctors of the university.
