

BCL requests PM to retake organisational chief post

Central leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the student wing of Bangladesh Awami League, on Monday requested Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to retake her post as their organisational chief, reports UNB.

The BCL leaders made the request at a press conference at its Bahgahandhu Avenue central office.

Sheikh Hasina Saturday relinquished her position as organizational chief of BCL, apparently annoyed at noisy activities by its leaders in several educational institutions.

In a written speech, BCL president Mahamud Hasan
