

Fake certificates seized by CID in city

The CID Police on Monday seized a huge number of fake certificates of different education boards and universities, rubber stamps and other equipment used for making the forged documents from the rented house of one Abdullah Al-Mamun in the city's Mothertek area, reports BSS.

Conducting a search in the house, police also seized non-judicial stamps of Taka 100 denomination, forged revenue stamps of Taka 50 denomination, four Taka denomination and stamps of the examination controller of Dhaka University, police said.

With the confessional statement of Mamun, CID police raided one Salahuddin's house at Lalmohan Saha Street and recovered huge number of forged blank educational certificates, negatives, stamps and rickshaw token of Dhaka City Corporation (DCC).

Later, they raided the house 66/1, Purana Moghultuli in Nawabpur road and seized a computer used for making the fake certificates and other documents.

Police arrested Al-Mamun, Salahuddin and the owner of the computer in these connection, they said.
