

KU teachers demand pay scale reformation

TEACHERS of Khulna University organised a human chain on the university campus on Monday demanding reformation of their pay scale.

The human chain was formed around 10:00am under the banner of Khulna University Teachers' Association with its acting president Professor Sardar Shafiqul Islam in the chair.

The vice-chancellor, Professor Fayek-uz-Zaman, expressed his full support for the demand of the teachers and said the proposed pay

scale did not reflect expectation of the teachers.

'We feel disgraced seeing position of senior professors in the proposed pay scale,' he said.

'We hoped that the prime minister would consider our demand sympathetically,' he further said.

He also demanded reformation of the pay scale before it was placed in the cabinet meeting for approval.

KUTA general secretary Professor Md Sarwar Jahan and general secretary of Swadhinata Shikkhak Parishad Professor Kazi Shahnewaz Ripon spoke, among others, at the programme.
