

Silver Jubilee of KU celebrated

KHULNA University alumni and students on Friday celebrated their alma mater's 'Silver Jubilee' and a reunion amid flowing festivity on the campus.

Inaugurated by the state minister for fisheries and livestock, Narayon Chandra Chanda, as chief, the opening function was presided over by the Vice-Chancellor of the university, Professor Dr. Mohammad Fayek Uzaman.

The day's programmes included introduction of Khulna University Alumni Association Committee, a discussion on role and impact of KU and its graduates on the society, launching of exhibitions and competitions on photography and paintings, staging cultural programme including pop band 'MILES' performance and a campfire.
