

BAU suspends two students for staying night at girls' hostel

THE authorities of Bangladesh Agricultural University suspended two students for staying night at a girls' dormitory on the campus on Sunday afternoon.

The authorities suspended Jibon Roy, a student of the Aquaculture department and Fatema Tuz Zohra, a student of Parasitology department of BAU.

The authorities suspended them under the Ordinance for Students Discipline Acts for one semester from the university as they were stayed illegally at a dormitory at night.

Sources said, Jibon on June 17, around 5:30pm went to the room no-122 of the girls' dormitory on the campus to meet Fatema. The security guard of the dormitory around 11:00pm asked Fatema about Jibon. She said that he went out of the room earlier.

But, the security guard had a doubt and he along with the other students of the dormitory checked her room and found Jibon under her bed.

The proctorial body later around 01.30am sent both the students to their respective halls after taking a written statement from them.

Latter, on June 18, the authorities served a show cause notice to the accused and asked them to reply within the next three days.

On the basis of their reply, on Sunday afternoon, the authorities suspended them for one semester from the university.
