

Teacher suspended after girl commits suicide.

THE authorities of Gono Bidya Niketan in Bongshal area of the city suspended a teacher and issued a show-cause notice to another teacher on Saturday, over the suicide of a girl allegedly after she failed to bear the punishment meted out to her by the suspended teacher on Thursday.

The actions were taken following an emergency meeting of the school managing committee on Saturday.

Contacted, additional deputy commissioner (Education and ICT) of Narayanganj Shaheen Ara Begum said teacher Qamrul Hasan Munna was suspended while another teacher Nasrin Sultana was issued the show-cause notice for their alleged involvement in the incident.

Earlier on Thursday Shraboni, a class IX student of Gono Bidya Niketan School

and daughter of Habib, a resident of Bongshal area, reportedly committed suicide by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room allegedly after failing to bear the punishment meted out to her by her school teacher.

Two teachers - Nasrin Sultana and Tanvila Tasrin - reportedly took Shraboni to Abdul Jabbar, assistant headmaster of the school, over an allegation of copying during an exam on Thursday morning.

Later, teacher Munna kept her standing on the school ground as punishment.

Later, the girl returned home and hanged herself from the ceiling of her room in absence of other house inmates.

As her abrupt return from school smelt wrong, neighbours entered the house and found Shraboni hanging from the ceiling.

They rushed her to Narayanganj General Hospital where doctors declared her dead.
