

No second chance for RU intake test

THE Rajshahi University authorities on Saturday decided to allow only the freshly passed HSC students to take the admission tests and only for once from the upcoming 2016-17 academic session.

The decision came at a meeting of the academic council held at the university's senate building in the evening, with vice-chancellor Muhammad Mizanuddin in the chair, confirmed RU registrar Professor Muhammad Entazul Huque.

The decision was made following a recommendation submitted by the university deans' committee, he added.

According to the new policy, students who passed HSC in 2015 would not be eligible for taking the admission test in the 2016-17 academic session, he also added.

Pro-vice-chancellor Sarwar Jahan told New Age that the decision was made to eliminate unequal competition between regular and irregular students.

Taking advantage of the opportunity of appearing in the test for a second time, many fresh students, who get enrolled in different universities, stop attending classes, and take preparations for the admission test again while the fresher only gets a little time for taking preparation.
