

# SUST teachers stage road march for VC's removal

THE pro-Awami League teachers of the Shahjalal University of Science and Technology on Thursday said that they would launch a tougher movement from Sunday if the vice-chancellor Aminul Haque Bhuiyan was not removed from the university.

They alleged that the vice-chancellor in association with the anti-independence quarter was trying to create unrest on the campus.

They also urged the government to remove the VC

from the university before any kind of unrest on the campus.

The teachers said this at a rally held in front of the vice-chancellor's office on the campus at the noon.

Muktijuddher Chetanay Udbuddha Shikkhak Parishad, a forum of the teachers inspired by the spirit of the Liberation War, convener Syed Shamsul Alam chaired the rally which was addressed, among others, by professor Muhammad Yunus and Syed Hasanuzzaman, associate professor Faruk Uddin and Sanjoy Ku-

mar Biswas.

Earlier, they organised the road march under the banner of MCUSP in front of the teachers' canteen on the campus and ended in front of the VC office after parading different main roads.

A section of pro-AL teachers under the banner of the MCUSP has been staging protest programmes on the campus for more than three months since April 20 in demand of the VC's withdrawal allegedly for his corruption, irregularities, nepotism and misbehaviors with the teachers.
