

Library beset with problems

COMILLA, Feb 9: Government Public Library at the Kaptan Bazar in the town is beset with manifold problems causing suffering to the readers, report UNB.

Normal functioning of the library is badly affected due to inadequate number of staff. Moreover, the books in the library are not properly classified and catalogued.

Readers alleged that they had to spend a lot of time to find a book as the books are not arranged in the shelf in scientific manner. As a result, researchers are facing problems in getting their necessary books.

They also complained that many valuable books have already been damaged due to negligence of the authorities.

Local people alleged that women and children section of the library remain closed almost all the time.

People in the area are also deprived of better service of the library as it is situated at a remote corner of the town. Some regular readers suggested that the library should be shifted to the centre of the town immediately.
