

Call to bring peace in Islamic University

KUSHTIA, Aug 11: Islamic University unit of BCL (A-A) called on the Vice-Chancellor Thursday and urged him to fulfil their 7-point demand to bring peaceful atmosphere in the campus, reports UNB.

The demands include implementation of the Varsity Ordinance 1973, reappointment of

teachers including Dr Hayat Mahmood and Dr Mustafizur Rahman, President and Secretary of Teachers Association respectively who were terminated earlier, completion of construction of the campus buildings, resuming of first year classes, allocation of seats in Saddam Hossein Hall, provision of subsidy in the canteen, granting of scholarships, supply of adequate books in the library, appointment of senior teachers and allowing student leader Harun to appear in the admission test.
