

Hons classes of Islamic Varsity begin

KUSHTIA, Sept. 13: The First year honours classes of the Islamic University began from Saturday, varsity sources said, reports UNB.

It may be mentioned that classes of the first year honours could not held on September 2 as scheduled earlier because of clashes between the activists of Islamic Chhatra Shibir and Bangladesh Chhatra League over taking possession of wall space for writing political slogans.

A five-member committee has also been formed to enquire into the incident that to the clash and injury of 10 students including 3 seriously.
