Islamic Varsity student hacked to death

JHENIDAH, Nov 26: A group of assailants Wednesday night hacked to death a student of the Islamic University and injured another at Harinarayanpur, 5 km from the university, police said, reports UNB.

The victim was identified as Saiful Islam Milon, 1st year student of Islamic History Department, who was killed on the spot at about midnight.

Rokonuzzaman, 1st year student of Law Department, is lying in Kushtia hospital with multiple stab injuries. His condition was stated to be critical.

In his statement of police, Rokonuzzaman said the assailants numbering about 25 and armed with lethal weapons were activists of Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya and Awami League backed BCL.

The assailants attacked the house where 16 students of the University were living.

Police said the attack was sequel of clashes between Chhatra Shibir and GCO-BCL in the University campus earlier in the day resulting in injuries to 50 students.

The University was immediately closed for a week and the students were ordered to vacate the dormitories.

Namaje Janaja of Saiful Islam was held at Kushtia Islamia College ground and the body was brought to his home in Bogra town for burial.

Meanwhile, rival groups of students clashed Jhenidah government college resulting in injuries to about 25 students.

activists of Shibir and GCO-BCL clashed when their procession confronted each other in the campus.

Police picked up 3 activists of GCO and a supporter of Shibir from the spot.

Angry students came out of the campus and damaged a truck and a police van.

Later, Chhatra Shibir in a protest rally at the Agrani Bank square announced a 'Doa Dibash' tomorrow (Friday) and mass-contact programme from November 28 to 30 all over the country.

Chhatra Moitree in a procession in the town demanded immediate release of their leaders and ban on Jamaat Shibir politics.
