IU closed sine die

KUSHTIA, Apr. 29.—The Islamic University was today (Saturday), declared closed sine die following Friday's killing of a guardian of an admission seeker on the campus during clashes between rival groups of students, reports UNB.

The university authorities announced the decision amidst mounting tension and asked the students to leave their respective halls before 5 p.m. today (Saturday).

Earlier, 11 students were arrested.

when police raided the halls Friday night. All of them were said to be the activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir.

Police also recovered one pistol, one Chinese axe and three 'kirich' during the raid.

Meanwhile, three seriously injured, who were hospitalised locally Friday night, were sent to Dhaka today (Saturday) for better treatment.

On Friday, guardian of an admission seeker was killed and three students were seriously injured in bomb blasts during a clash between the activists of Islamic Chhatra Shibir and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal on the IU campus.

Seriously injured Azam (30), an elected ward commissioner of Kumarkhali municipality and guardian of a girl student, was declared dead when he was rushed to the Kushtia Sadar Hospital.
