Impartial role of IU authorities demanded

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY (Kush-tia). Nov 5.—Zia Parishad and Green Forum, two separate teachers organisations of the Islamic University, on Wednesday submitted a memorandum to the Vice-Chancellor demanding impartial role of the authorities, reports UNB.

The teachers' action came in the wake of BCL-Shibir gun fight in the campus on Saturday in which 50 students including 11 policemen were injured. Two of the injured Shibir Activists later died in the hospital.

The teachers alleged that the authorities failed to maintain peace in the campus and its partisan role in handling the campus situation.

Sources close to the VC's office said there had been exchange of hot words when the teachers accused the Vice-Chancellor of playing a partisan role.

Meanwhile, a group of Shibir activists brought out a procession in Jhenidah town to mourn the death of two Shibir activists—Mohsin Kabir and Al Mamun—who were injured in Saturday's clash.

They accused BCL for the killing and demanded punishment to the killers.
