Professor Wahid receives Ahsanullah gold medal

Professor Emeritus of BUET and President of Bangladesh Diabetic Association Professor Dr. Wahid Uddin Ahmed have been nominated for award of 'Khanbahadur Ahsanullah Gold Medal-2001' for his remarkable contributions in the field of education and social work.

The award will be handed over to him formally in a function to be organised for the purpose soon. This Gold Medal was introduced in 1965 in the name of the renowned educationist, social reformer and spiritual mentor of this sub-continent Khanbahadur Ahsanullah (1873-1965) who is also the founder of Dhaka Ahsania Mission, with a view to honour those best sons of the soil who have noteworthy contributions for the cause of the country.

The former recipients of the award are Mohammd Ferdaus Khan, Dr Mohammad Ibrahim, S.M. Al-Hosainy, Sayed Ali Ahsan, Dewan Mohammad Azraf, Azizul Huq, Dr. M.R. Khan, Chief Justice Mostafa Kamal and Mohammad Shamsul Haque, says a Press release.

Dr Ahmed was a member of the Council of the Association of Commonwealth Universities, a trustee of the Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok, Thailand, Chairman of the National Educational Environment Committee, Member, Bangladesh National Commission for UNESCO, Member, Bangladesh University Grants Commission and a member of the Board of Governors of Bangladesh Administrative Staff College. Presently he is working as the Professor Emeritus of BUET and the full time President of the Bangladesh Diabetic Association.
