



JCD cadres beat 4 students at BUET Hall

Cadres of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) beat up four demonstrating students of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) at Suhrawardi Hall early Sunday.

Campus sources said some 10-12 JCD cadres led by Atik and Nayan dragged out Sharif, Shamim, Sabbir and Prosenjit from their beds at about 3:00 am and took outside their rooms.

They beat them and asked not to participate in any demonstration.

Protesting the attack, the BUET students Unity Against Terrorism held a rally in front of the BUET Auditorium in the noon. Some senior teachers including the Pro-vost of Suhrawardi Hall tried to drive out the students, witnesses said.

On the second day after re-opening of BUET, almost all the classes were held.

But the demonstrating students are feeling insecure in the dormitories following the attack.

Earlier on Saturday night the dialogue between the authorities and the demonstrators ended in a fiasco.

The students said the authorities were still rigid on their stance. No dialogue could be held in such a situation, said one who took part in the dialogue.
