

15 hurt in Shibir attack

**SCF calls
indefinite
siege in CU**

CHITTAGONG, June 26.—
Samajtantrik Chhatra Front (SCF)
called an indefinite siege pro-
gramme on the campus following
an attack by Islami Chhatra Shibir
(ICS) activists, which left more
than 15 SCF workers injured in-
cluding its President this after-
noon.

The seriously injured SCF ac-
tivists were identified as President
of CU unit of SCF Monjurul Huq
Monju, Organizing Secretary
Daipayan Barua Roni, Kolin
Chakma, Suman Bonik, Ripa
Sardar, Saifuddin, Dipa, Lipi,
Moni. The injured activists of
SCF were admitted to different
clinics of the city.

According to the witnesses a
group of ICS workers asked Kolin
Chakma to stop his campaigning
for his organization to raise
movement against the recent fees
hike decision of the university
authority at the university railway
station square at about 2:30 p.m.

The ICS workers with lethal
arms threatened Kolin Chakma
that the SCF will face serious
difficulty if they do not give up
their movement against the recent
fees hike decision of the authority.

At that time Kolin Chakma and
some other workers of SCF pro-
tested the aggressive movement of
the ICS workers and locked in hot
conversation. At one stage of the
hot conversation the ICS workers
started to beat Kolin Chakma and
other workers of SCF with arms.
Seeing their workers in danger
other leaders and workers of the
SCF also came on the spot and
tried to rescue their party people.
But the armed ICS workers also
beat them.
