

## CU syndicate meeting postponed

Chittagong University (CU) authority postponed the syndicate meeting scheduled for yesterday due to tense situation on the campus.

Sources said the meeting was convened to approve the extension of the tenure of acting registrar Ahmedul Haque Chowdhury for the second time.

But, strong objections from teachers and employees led to the postponement of the syndicate meeting, the sources added.

The Chittagong University Teachers' Association (CUTA) at a meeting on Thursday adopted a resolution condemning the move to extend the tenure of acting registrar. CUTA President ANM Munir Ahmed was in the chair.

The Employees Co-ordination Committee (ECC) was also scheduled to stage protest against the move yesterday.

When contacted, Vice-Chancellor Prof. AJM Nuruddin Chowdhury said the meeting has been postponed in view of the worsening situation created following the clashes among the student organisations.
