Postponement of DU Fine Arts Instt admission test demanded

The students of Fine Arts Institute of Dhaka University demanded postponement of the admission test for session 2002-03 held on January 25 bringing allegations of licking out of the question papers of the admission test.

The students also submitted a memorandum to the Director of the Institute to press home their three-point demands. The demands include: postponement of the admission test and re-examination of the admission test, suspension of the alleged teacher relating to licking out question papers and checking out the administrative irregularities and corruption of the institute.

The students also vowed to call strike on the campus if their demands were not met immediately.

The students alleged that an assistant professor of the institute who is also an owner of a private admission coaching center licked out the question papers of the admission test.

It is alleged that almost 50% question of the admission test came from the model test of the coaching center.

The students will stage a rally at the Institute today (Tuesday) on the same issue.
