

Corruption case against former DU VC Azad, Treasurer filed

The Bureau of Anti-Corruption (BAC) on Sunday filed a corruption case against former vice-chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. Dr. Abul Kalam Azad Chowdhury and Treasurer of the University Prof. Mohammad Shamsul-Haq, reports BSS.

A task force of the BAC charged Prof. Chowdhury and Prof. Haq saying "Their action for taking loan of Taka 3 crore by abusing administrative power caused a financial loss of Taka 75.312 of the university".

BAC Inspector Mohammad Golam Faniq filed the case with Ramna Police Station after preliminary investigation.

The Inspector during the investigation found that the former DU vice-chancellor took the loan of Taka 3 crore against a DU FDR of Taka 3.44 lakh to pay outstanding bills of contractors. According to the statute of the university, the Syndicate can only do this job.
