



Shafiqur Rahman resigns from DUTA

Prof. Shafiqur Rahman of Law department has resigned from the Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) on Monday.

"The DUTA is now turned into a political organisation, and does not serve the interest of the teachers. So there is no reason to remain here" Shafiqur Rahman said while justifying the reason behind his resignation.

It is noted that in the last week the DUTA in an emergency meeting decided to cancel the membership of Shafiqur Rahman from the organisation for his alleged indecent remarks on Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia and Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. SMA Faiz.

The ruling party backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) staged demonstration on the campus demanding immediate resignation of Shafiqur Rahman from the university on the day.
