

BCS silver jubilee at JU tomorrow

SAVAR, Jan 8:—The three-day-long Bangladesh Chemical Society (BCS) Silver Jubilee Conference-2003 will begin in Jahangirnagar University (JU) on January 11.

President of Bangladesh Prof Dr Iajuddin is likely to inaugurate the conference formally as chief guest at JU auditorium at 10 am.

Minister for Health and Family Welfare Dr Khandaker Mosharrat Hossain, Minister for Environment and Forest Shajahan Siraj and State Minister for Energy and Mineral Resources AKM Mosharrat Hossain will also attend the inaugural session as special guests.

A total of 150 papers will be presented in the conference which will be attended by around 700 participants.
