## 500 examinees, 8 invigilators expelled

Around 500 examinees were expelled for adopting unfair means on the 4th day of the Higher secondary Certificate (HSC), Alim and Fazil examinations.

Eight invigilators were also expelled across the country for their alleged assistance in cheating during the examinations.

Some 300 examinees were expelled from seven general education boards. 60 examinees were expelled from the Madrasha education board and 120 examinees were expelled from Technical education board during the Bangla 2nd paper examination, held on Monday.

The trend of cheating in examination has declined a government took measures to check the unfair means in examination including summary trial court, fine, restriction on people's movement and installation of close circuit video cameras at the examination centres.

Sources said, the highest 133 examinees and one invigilator were expelled from Rajshahi Education Board for cheating in the examination.

Eighty-nine examinees were expelled from Dhaka Education Board. One invigilator was also expelled at Gazipur Bhaowal Degree College examination centre for helping the examinees in cheating. 21 examinees were expelled from Barishal and 19 examinees were expelled from Jessore education board.

Thirty-four examinees were expelled from Chittagong Education Board, while the Comilla Education Board expelled 17 examinees.

As many as 10 students were expelled from the Sylhet Education Board, and the 61 students from Technical Education Board.

Twenty-one examinees were expelled in Madrasha Education Board for adopting unfair means in the examination. Six invigilators, 3 in Naogaon and 3 in Gazipur were also expelled for their alleged assistance in cheating in the examination.

A total of 659,826 examinees are appearing in the examination from 16,000 centres across the country under Dhaka, Rajshahi, Comilla, Chittagong, Barishal, Sylhet, Jessore Education Board and the Bangladesh Madrasha Education Board and Technical Education Board.
